The Board of Finance met at the Durham Town Hall, 30 Town House Road, on Tuesday, April 3, 2007. Chairman Fran Korn called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

Fran and Loraine worked on the new budget sheets with Maryjane and they are not reconciled to Maryjane and MUNIS.

New 3016 Highway Sweeping for \$23,000 has been put back in the budget.

In the Town Clerk's office the overtime for the Assistant Town Clerk and the intern are in the budget at this time.

1000 Board of Finance

MOTION BY ELMER CLARK, SECONDED BY ROB DESIMIONE TO APPROVE BUDGET 1000 – BOARD OF FINANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,210. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

1010 Office of the First Selectman

MOTION BY ROB DESIMIONE, SECONDED BY LORAIN COE TO APPROVE BUDGET 1010 – OFFICE OF THE FIRST SELECTMAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,595. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY. Included in this budget is the \$250.00 for Towing.

1011 – First Selectman Salary

MOTION BY ROB DESIMIONE, SECONDED BY LORAIN COE TO APPROVE BUDGET 1011 – FIRST SELECTMAN SALARY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$69,064. THIS REFLECTS AN INCREASE OF 15.16%.

Discussion followed: Jay Berardino felt that a 15.16% increase is unwarranted given the fact that we have a new Finance Director who has picked up quite a bit of the work. Elmer Clark felt we should set the salary at July 1, 07-08 increase recommended by the salary committee. Fran Korn is not comfortable with this increase and feels we should get it to the public hearing. According to Elmer the March 8, 2006 minutes only discussed seven people who were elected officials. He feels we should only adjust the salaries once a year on July 1<sup>st</sup>. Loraine Coe said this would have happened earlier but the study just came back. Loraine said the employees were informed about

the retroactive. Elmer said that there was nothing in the Capital budget for the retroactive amounts.

Fran is uncomfortable with this and feels we should bring this to the public meeting and let them decide. It cannot be raised any more than it is only reduced.

Discussion: Elmer did not feel that the person that was hired in September should have any adjustment until next September. Loraine said they discussed the increase in September but it would be more cumbersome. Jay stated that everyone seemed very happy with Maryjane's work but it was almost an 8% increase. Loraine said we had asked for a study and this is what was brought back to us. She feels we should bring it to the town. Jay feels that the Finance Department is going to save us a lot of money. Loraine said that she has helped us a great deal with the budget alone.

MOTION BY LORAIN COE, SECONDED BY JAY BERARDINO TO APPROVE BUDGET 1526 FINANCE DEPARTMENT SALARIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$109,427.

At this point the Board took a brief recess to listen to the presentation of Brian Ameche for the Conservation Commission. They are requesting \$18,030.

Brian stated that we have a Stewardship program and that they manage the property very well. He also said that we are partnering with the Regional Water Authority to purchase some 60 acres from the Water Authority. We have no projects of our own at this time. The Stewards notify us if there are any problems on the property and who is on the property. The problem we had was enforcement of who was allowed on the property but with the Stewardship program the land is being watched and enforced. Management of property has been our primary concern, acquiring new lands is secondary. We do not have a survey of White's property and we need to get the boundaries. Elmer remembered something about a survey being done in the 1960's. Brian said there is no survey as far as he knows, but will check with Sue White.

The other program that Brian wants funds for is the Calendar. This year he needs \$5,000 for the photography. Next year he needs \$9,500 for the rest of the Calendar. Fran said that they have \$5,000 in reserve from this year and \$4,500 left over from last year. If we put another \$5,000 in for next year the money will be there for the Calendar. The only thing is that he will have to go to a Town Meeting to get the money. That was fine with Brian. Also Fran stated that anything that is put in Reserve could be reappropriated. Brian said that the photos show from the 50's Durham as it was and the new photos show the present time. Brian wanted to put some money away for maintenance on the barn. Fran said that the money could come out of contingency.

Loraine wanted to know who mows Whites Farm? Brian said Sue White takes care of the mowing, there is no value in the hay, it is too wet Jay said that the State of Connecticut will do a survey for free because the land borders state land. Brian will look into this.

Laura Francis wanted to answer questions about the Assistant Town Clerk overtime and the summer intern. Fran said there are no questions about the overtime and the intern was still in the budget but wanted to know what jobs the intern helped with at the Town Hall. Laura said that in the beginning no one knew quite what to do with the summer intern but over the years the intern has been used for coverage during the summer months, entering vital statistics, transferring data from old programs to new. She feels we are obligated to do this for the town. She feels it would be difficult to get someone to volunteer to do this work since most college students have to find

work for the summer months to help their expenses. Also it was a concern that the insurance would not cover interns. Jan Muraca was looking into this matter. Laura was concerned about putting it into the Selectmen's budget since the Selectmen were not in favor of the intern.

The 2535 budget – Special Acts and Ordinances if for the Code of Ordinances. We pay a company to codify it and for maintenance on the website. This company puts it on the website and it is available for anyone who wants to see it. It was suggested to put this item and Vital Statistics in the Town Clerk budget.

The IT budget is probably a lot more than we would need. She wanted to work with Scott Wright but he does not have the time. Laura would like to pursue the original plan to form a stakeholders committee to come up with a plan for the Audiovisual plan for the conference rooms in the Town Hall. Once the committee comes up with a plan Fran would like them to come back to us. Fran stated that the Board of Selectmen would have to appoint the committee.

Laura said servers are necessary at this time. One of the servers is very new but the other is quite old.

The records management software is being checked into. They want to have a consultant give us a quote for the entire Town Hall. She proposes to use grant money for this system. This can be put off for a while so Laura can look into what grants are available.

At 8:00 the meeting was reconvened.
