## Volunteer Opportunity – October 2009

### White's Farm Work Party

Durham Conservation Commission and the Friends of White's Farm will hold a work party from 8 am to 12 noon on the next two Saturdays, October 17<sup>th</sup> and October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009. The goal of each will be to clear unwanted vegetation from sections of White's Farm and consolidate debris into brush piles for removal by Public Works. The event is rain or shine, but lightning cancels.

**Who & Where:** The Conservation Commission is one of the land use boards in the Town of Durham, and one of its duties is to manage town-owned open space, including White's Farm on Maple Avenue, just north of the Fair Grounds.

**1. When:** October 17th. **Focus:** Clearing brush from the old nursery and drainage ditches.

**What to Bring:** Water, sturdy boots, thick work gloves, rain gear, powered brush saws and gas (if you have them), and heavy iron rakes. Some tools will be available, and people to handle and move brush are always needed.

**2. When:** October 24th. **Focus:** Removing vegetation from ditches running along the access road.

**What to Bring:** Water, sturdy boots (waterproof preferable), work gloves, powered brush saws and gas (if you have them), rakes, and haying forks. Some tools will be available, and people to pile debris from the ditches will be in demand.
