

DURHAM HISTORIC COMMISSION
Hearings and Meetings
Thursday June 2, 2005

Call to order: The hearing was called to order at 8:00pm., by chairman, Alan Reed
Members Present: Linda Bertelsen, Clay Howe, Norman Jason, Alan Reed, and Gordon Wolfgang.

Members Absent: Tricia Dynia, Duncan Milne and George Zeeb

The legal notice for **APCOA #307** was read by the chairman and minutes were taken by Linda Bertelsen in the absence of Tricia Dynia. Hans Pederson made a brief presentation on the ramp and railing to be built on the rear of 68 Main Street. The hearing was closed at 8:06 p.m. At 8:07 p.m. a meeting was held on APCOA #307. Norman Jason made a motion to approve the application seconded by Gordon Wolfgang. The vote was unanimous in favor of the application.

At 8:14 p.m. there was a call to order for a second hearing on **APCOA #308** by Alan Reed. The same members were present and absent. The legal notice was read and Mark Jungles the builder showed architectural drawings for the new addition at the rear of 36 Maiden Lane. Commissioners asked a few questions to clarify work to be done and the hearing was closed.

At 8:21 Norman Jason made a motion to approve the plans, seconded by Gordon Wolfgang. A vote was taken and all members approved.

New Business

The owners of the home at 313 Main Street after being visited by the Durham Enforcement Officer and the chairman of the Historic District Commission agreed to move the satellite dish from the front of the house to a rear location. At this time the dish has been moved.

Beginning with the July meeting the commission will meet in the town library as work is scheduled to begin on the town hall.

The Walking Tour Brochure is being printed at this time. An event to promote the brochure and the district is being planned.
