

DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

Minutes of the meeting, December 4, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 6:40 PM. In attendance were committee members Frank DeFelice, Jim Rossi, Mal Pierce and Bill Smith. Also in attendance was Resident State Trooper Pete DiGioia. A letter was read to the committee from John Szewczyk announcing his resignation from the committee. Richard Parmalee asked the committee the status of the Tuttle Road/Saw Mill Road/Parmalee Hill Road intersection. The committee informed him that it was discussed at the last Board of Selectmen meeting. Signage will be added and visibility will be improved at the intersection. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

The recent burglaries on Main Street were discussed. The committee and resident trooper feel that policing options for the town should be re-examined. The discussion on a traffic standard operating procedure was tabled due to Dan Murphy's absence. The committee decided that 2008 meetings would be on the second Tuesday of every month, pending availability of the room at the library. Bill Smith is continuing to work on options for the "Welcome To Durham" sign. Committee plans for next year were discussed. Among the items discussed were re-starting the street numbering program and verifying the snow removal policy with the Board of Selectmen. There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:41 PM.
