

## **DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

Minutes of the meeting, April 13,2005

The meeting was called to order at 6:32. In attendance were Frank DeFelice, Bill Smith, Jim Rossi, John Shefcyk and Dan Murphy. Town wide First Aid/CPR training was discussed. Lisa Ezzo from Lake Grove School gave a presentation to the committee. She is a certified trainer and employed by Lake Grove School. The school will donate her services as instructor and the facilities to perform the classes. The only costs to be incurred will be a Red Cross fee of \$6.00 per certification and the costs of the books, if the trainee desires to keep it (\$15 for a full CPR/first aid book or \$1.50 for a workplace training booklet). The committee decided that no one younger than 16 should attend the training .The committee will ask the First Selectwoman to generate a list of town employees that she wishes to undergo the training. Additional classes will be scheduled as demand requires. The emergency preparedness brochure was discussed. The committee will get bids on two different versions-a large refrigerator magnet version and a small two-sided card to be mailed to each household. There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:35.
