**Minutes of the meeting, July 13,2005**

**The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. In attendance were Frank DeFelice, Bill Smith, Jim Rossi, John Shefcyk and Dan Murphy. Minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted. The budget of the committee was discussed; specifically carrying over unused funds to the next fiscal year for town wide Red Cross CPR training .The first CPR class for town employees will be held July 20<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 to 12:30. 8 town employees are scheduled to attend .The committee discussed the Crooked Hill Road subdivision, located in Guilford but only accessible on Durham roads. The committee chairman will present the Guilford Planning and Zoning Committee a letter expressing the concerns of the committee with regards to public safety at their next meeting, scheduled for July 20 .The Durham Public Safety Committee voted unanimously on the wording of the letter and for Frank to present it to the Guilford P&Z.New committee membership and mission statements were distributed. They will be mailed to members who were not present. Frank will e-mail it to all members for input and suggestions. The newest Blockwatch neighborhood will commence in the second week in August. It will cover the upper half of David Road. There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:48 PM.**
