

# **DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

**Minutes of the meeting, October 12, 2005**

**The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. In attendance were Frank DeFelice, Bill Smith, Jim Rossi, John Szewczyk and Dan Murphy. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted .The floor was opened for public comment from Donia Viola .The first comment concerned the use of the 911 system for non-emergencies. Her second comment concerned the dumping of leaves and snow in the road, blocking complete access. John will research if there is a town or state ordinance concerning unauthorized dumping on town roads.**

**The proposed stop sign at the Cherry Lane-Old Blue Hills Road intersection was discussed. Several committee members made site visits and photographs were viewed of the intersection .The committees opinion is that the existing stop sign on Old Blue Hills Road is not easily visible under all conditions and is obscured by roadside vegetation. The committee recommends re-application of the painted stop bar at the stop sign on Old Blue Hills Road and removal of the brush blocking the view of Cherry Lane from Old Blue Hills Road as a first step .The committee would appreciate feedback on this suggestion from the town crew foreman.**

**The Ozick Drive parking situation was discussed .The committee voted to recommend that “No Parking This Side” signs be installed on the east side of Ozick Drive. The committee will monitor the situation.**

**The CPR business training discussion was tabled until next month.**

**There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.**
