

## **DURHAM PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

Minutes of the meeting, September 13, 2006

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. In attendance were Frank DeFelice, Bill Smith, Jim Rossi, John Szewczyk and Dan Murphy. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted. Frank presented a draft of the "State Police Activities in the town of Durham, CT-2003-2005". The committee suggested some minor edits and voted unanimously to accept the report.

Mica Hill Road sight lines were discussed. Charles and Sally Doe sent the committee a letter concerning the curve on Mica Hill Road. Stopping sight distances and designated sight distances were discussed. The committee will visit the area and generate a list of suggested options for the Board of Selectmen.

The mailbox/house numbering program was discussed. The list of houses that did not have numbers visible from the road on the house or mailbox was reviewed. The list was broken into five groups (one for each member present) and each member will verify the status for numbers visible from the street for emergency services or not visible for further action.

Bill Smith reported the SMART radar trailer would be in town in two weeks. The town of Killingworth is using the machine at this time. The Maple Avenue traffic situation was discussed. The committee recommends that the first place the SMART trailer should be used is on Maple Avenue to gather data on traffic numbers and speed to aid in our recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:02PM.
