

## **SKATING POND COMMITTEE** **6-21-2005 MEETING MINUTES**

Attendees: Chairman Dave Monroe; Simone Howe, acting secretary

Meeting called to order by Dave Monroe @ 7:05 p.m. in the Durham Public Library.

Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed.

Dave Monroe presented a copy of the Memorandum from Brian C. Curtis dated June 14, 2005 which outlined his recommendations for repairs and upgrades to the existing skating pond off Route 68 in Durham. We reviewed the document and thank Brian profusely for his help with this project.

Dave then reported on the meeting with the Inland Wetland Commission on Monday, June 13, 2005 where Dave Monroe and Brian Curtis presented the committee's plan to make repairs and improvements to the existing skating pond. Their comments were well received by the committee.

Our Committee is on the agenda of the Inland Wetland Commission's meeting scheduled for July 12<sup>th</sup>, 2005 to request a permit to proceed with the maintenance project.

Dave Monroe has asked that our committee be placed on the Board of Selectman's agenda for the meeting of June 27, 2005 as we were initially charged with "investigating and recommending to the Board of Selectman a safe and feasible skating area" which we are ready to do. Simone Howe suggested that we request further guidance from the Board of Selectman as to what role our committee will have, if any, in the completion of the project. Dave will notify committee members by phone if we are placed on the agenda for June 27

Dave did state that Tommy Russell of Durham is willing to do some of the work required to improve the skating pond.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 PM.
