

SKATING POND COMMITTEE

10-18-2005 MEETING MINUTES

Attendees: Dave Monroe, chairman; Simone Howe, acting secretary; Tim Larkin

Meeting called to order by Dave Monroe @ 7:05 p.m. in the Durham Public Library.

Dave Monroe reported the following:

Dave submitted a budget to DEP to secure the DEP grant, along with a letter describing the plan to repair the pond.

Dave Roach from All Habitat, Inc. cut back the reeds in the pond and will spray the invasive purple loosestrife as recommended by the Inland Wetland and Watercourses Agency. Dave will discuss payment for this service with Maryann Boord.

Dave attended the recent Town Meeting at which the motion to accept the \$50,000 grant from the Bond Commission Allocation for the purpose of developing a skating area was approved. However, the request was made that we obtain several more bids for the site work and the electrical work.

Brian Curtis will do site checks and supervise the work to ensure that it is done according to the blueprints that he has drawn up.

We reviewed our Second Charge dating from July 11, 2005. We agreed that we have accomplished all of the charges. While Dave contacted CIRMA some time ago, he has not yet heard back from CIRMA about the formal recommendations concerning risk control measures, and he will again contact CIRMA before the next meeting. Dave will ask Maryann Boord if the Board of Selectman will present us with a Third Charge.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30PM. The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, November 1 at 7PM at the Durham Public Library. The public is invited to attend.
