# NOTICE

## You are enrolled in the newly recognized Independent Political Party of CT

Your voter registration application indicates “Independent” for party status.

As of 2008 the Independent Party became an officially recognized minor party in each CT town. This is because they ran Ralph Nader for President in 2008 and he received at least 1% of the votes cast for the office of President.

If you meant to register as an unaffiliated voter, one who does not belong to any political party, you will need to fill out a new voter registration application form.

If you wish to change your party to another party, there will be a delay before you can vote in a caucus or primary, but you can vote in other elections. **Party enrollment transfers** take three months – Any elector who transfers from one political party to another shall not be entitled to vote in any caucus or primary or be entitled to party privileges for a period of **three months** after such enrollment change.
